
Athletic Covenant

Activities like sports are an opportunity and a privilege offered our students at the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade levels. We encourage participation in some activity for each student. Extracurricular events are another aspect of education and give students valuable lessons about teamwork, effort, interest, development of skills, work ethic, character, and social skills necessary for dealing with people in today's world.

We also encourage and support our students to keep the academic area as a priority in this time of exploration. As a school support with this, teachers assess each student in activities each week in the following areas:

1. Positive behavior/participation in class and class activities (especially in those classes such as art, music, and physical education where class time is so important because they only meet once a week and the nature of learning demands student involvement).
2. Completed all assignments (not just written work) on time, with quality, and following directions. No more than one late assignment per subject per week. With second late assignment in a week, teachers give notice on the activities form filed for the athletic director each week on Monday. Teachers tell students that their performance has not met these standards, resulting in a check on the activity form, and send a brief note home with the student.
3. Passed quizzes and tests satisfactorily.

The athletic director passes the list of students for each activity around to each teacher on Monday for review of the previous week. If the student receives a check in two or more subject areas, they will be ineligible for one game/match at each level of competition in which they compete. They will be ineligible for the first game/match at each level of competition occurring between the Wednesday following the Monday evaluation and the following Tuesday. The teacher evaluation form is sent to the athletic director on Monday and the athletic director notifies the coaches on Tuesday. If there is any breakdown in this process of communication, please inform the student, teacher, or coach first, then the athletic director if necessary, and then consult the principal if the situation is not resolved.
