

Reunion July 5, 1965

The third Immaculate Conception High School Alumni Reunion was held July 3, 1965 in the Izaak Walton Clubhouse on Gilbertville Road.

It consisted of a dinner and dance planned by several members of the class of 1948. Dinner was served by members of the Izaak Walton Club. The "Don Hickey Trio" played for the dance. There were 95 people present.

The host class sat at the head table. The ten-year class, the class of 1955, was featured at the center table.

Leo Brustkern acted as toastmaster. After the meal, Leo Delagardelle read the letters from out-of-town non-attending guests. John Becker spoke for his class, the class of 1955. Mildred Girsch-Canfield from Rochester, Minnesota, told what a pleasure it was to see old friends and places.

There were 104 letters with return post cards enclosed, sent out telling of the reunion. (85 replied) (49 said yes and 36 said no).

There was some discussion of annual dues or a deposit at the time of reservations, to ease the burden on the planning committee. It took the gracious effort of Marvin Meinert passing the hat to meet the evening's expenses.

Final decisions as to the how, what, and when for the next reunion was left up to the class of 1950. They are next in line to host a reunion.
