This year we have decided to host the Post Prom at The Cedar Falls REC Center. We are working on have a Hypnotist there also. Please join us for this meeting.

Although Post Prom is not until April it takes months to raise money and organize this event. This brings us to the reason for this letter. Once again, we will be participating in the Younkers, Community Day Sale which will take place on Saturday November 14th. It's a day of shopping and fun, not to mention a great opportunity for our organization to raise much needed funds. If you've never done this, you won't want to miss out. It's a great day to do some Christmas shopping.

Here's how it works:

- Younkers will provide us with coupon booklets at NO charge. Donate \$5, Get \$10.
- We are asking each family to sell 4 booklets for \$5.00 each
- Those who purchase coupon booklets are able to take advantage of a single regular or sale price merchandise item of \$10 or more, which means that you've been doubly paid back for your donation.
- Plus an EARLY BIRD coupon for 30% off a single regular or sale price apparel item. Until 9:00 A.M. on Sat.
- There's more. – You also get Six - 20% off coupons. Coupons are valid on regular and sale price merchandise. (Excludes Door Busters and Bonus Buys)
- You can shop early and they will hold it for you. Customers select merchandise prior to the day of the event. The associate rings the sale on November 14th and have it ready for the customer to pick up. Customers may pick up their presale anytime before the close of business on Monday, Nov. 16th. No waiting in lines.

Best of all, we retain the entire \$5 from each booklet that we sell! It's that easy.

Some of you have received your coupons without this letter. That is because we are trying to save on postage. Plus we are GOING GREEN. That is why you are also getting most of the info on the web-site. If you have not received your coupon booklets and have internet access we are still trying to hand deliver them. Let us know the best way to get them to you and we will do that. They will be available in the school office.

Please return your money in an envelope marked "Post Prom" to one of us or to the Don Bosco office on or before November 10th. We are expecting each of you to sell 4 or more books, however, in the event that you do not sell them all they will need to be returned before the above date. Please make sure that your name is clearly marked on the envelope
